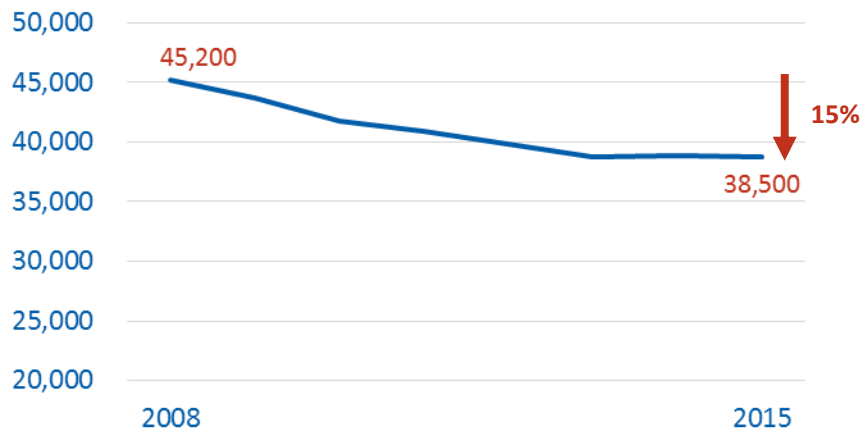


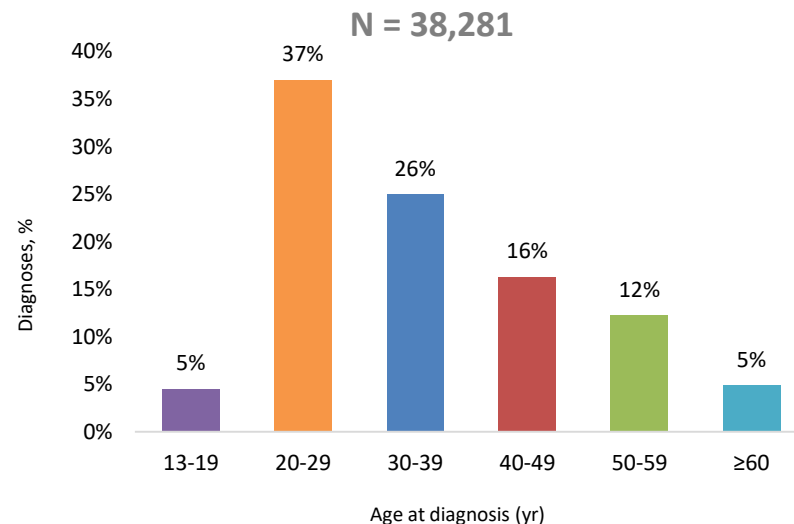
Estimate annual HIV infections in the U.S. declined **15%** from 2008-2015



Prevented 33,700 cases at estimated cost savings for medical care of \$16 billion

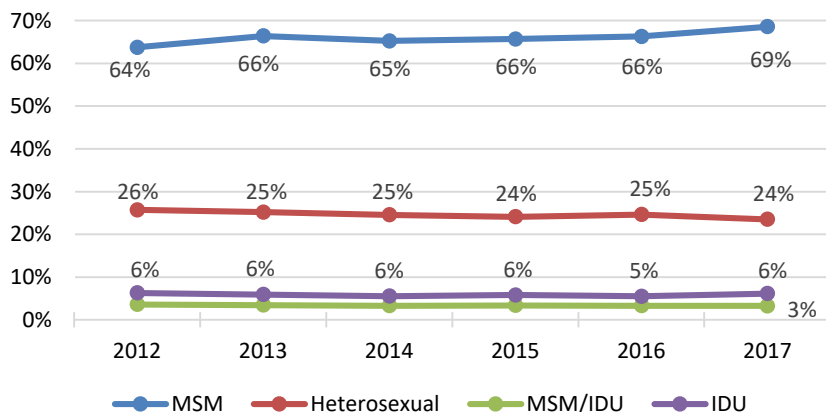

Diagnoses of HIV Infection among Adults and Adolescents by Age at Diagnosis, 2017—United States



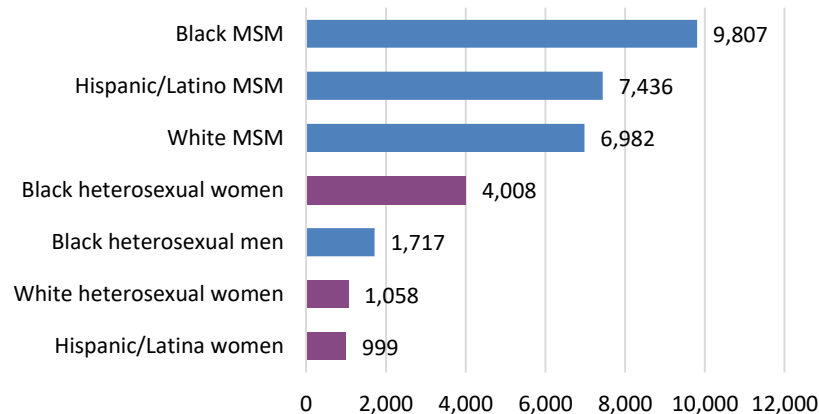

Estimated HIV Diagnoses by Route of Transmission, 2017



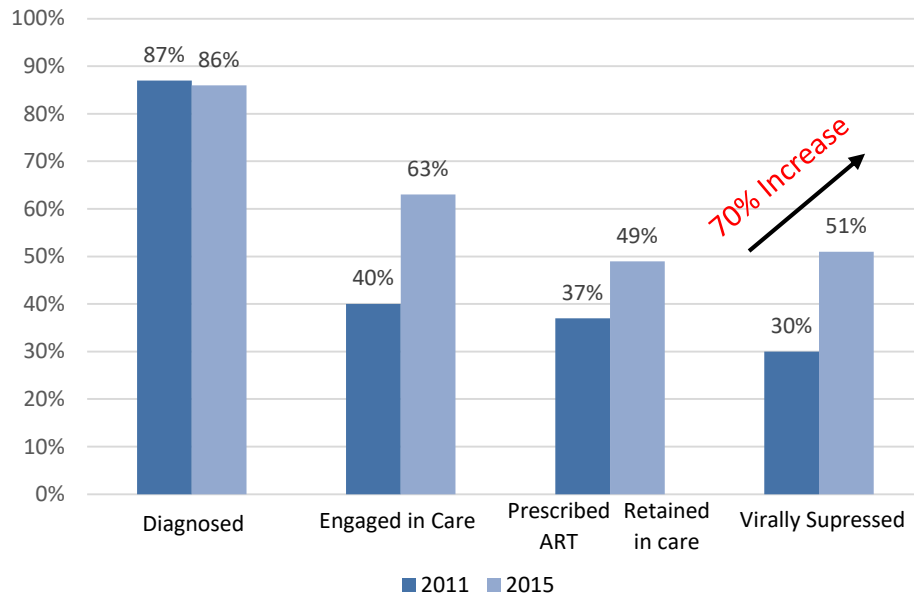

New HIV Diagnoses in the United States for the Most-Affected Subpopulations, 2017



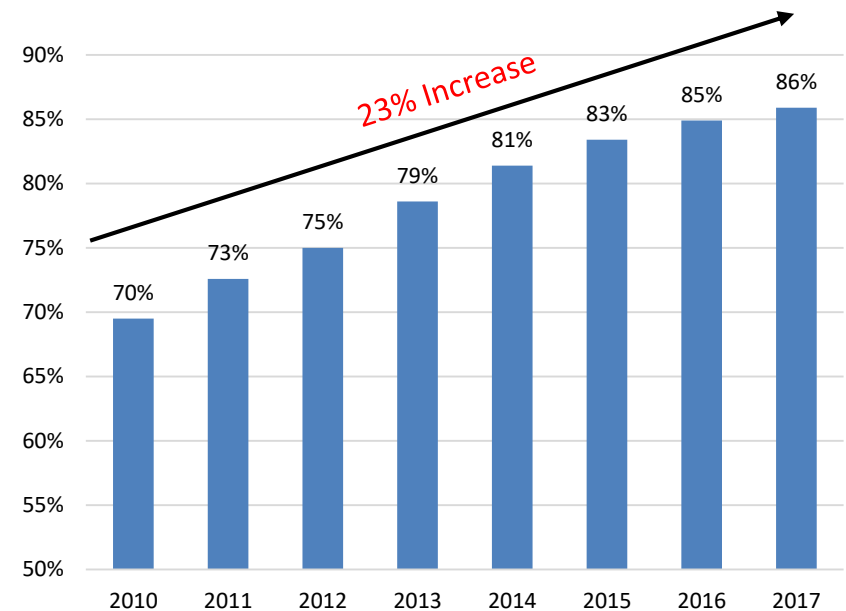

Ryan White Viral Suppression, 2010-2017

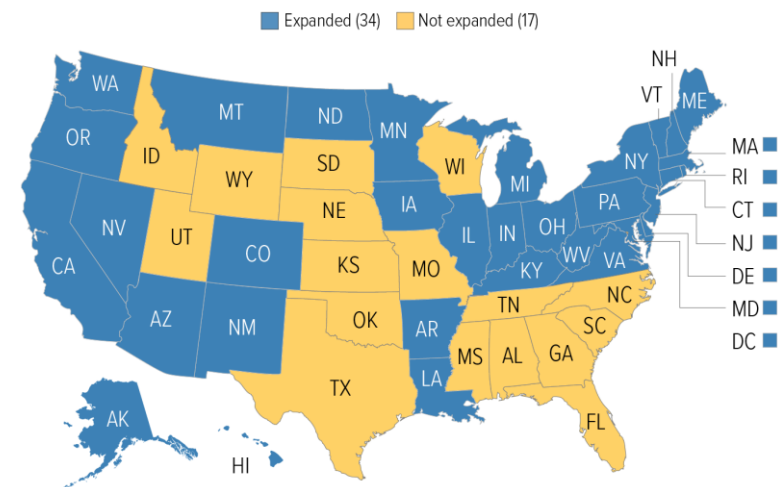
